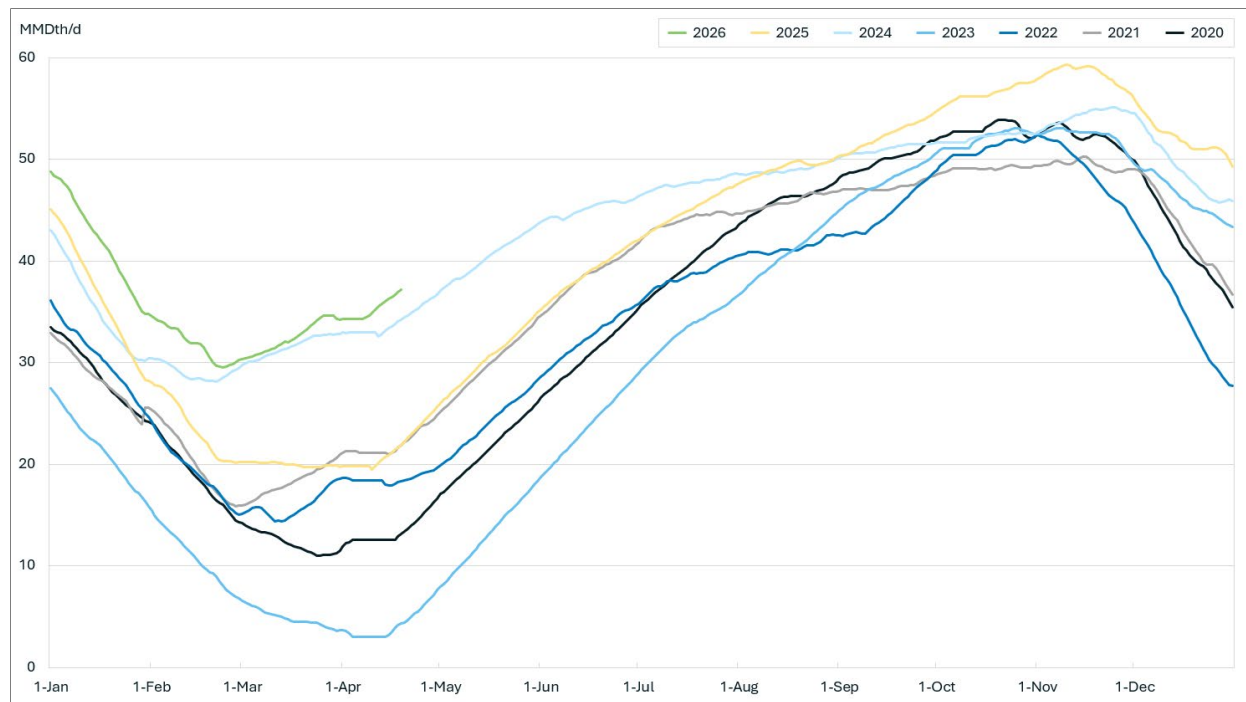

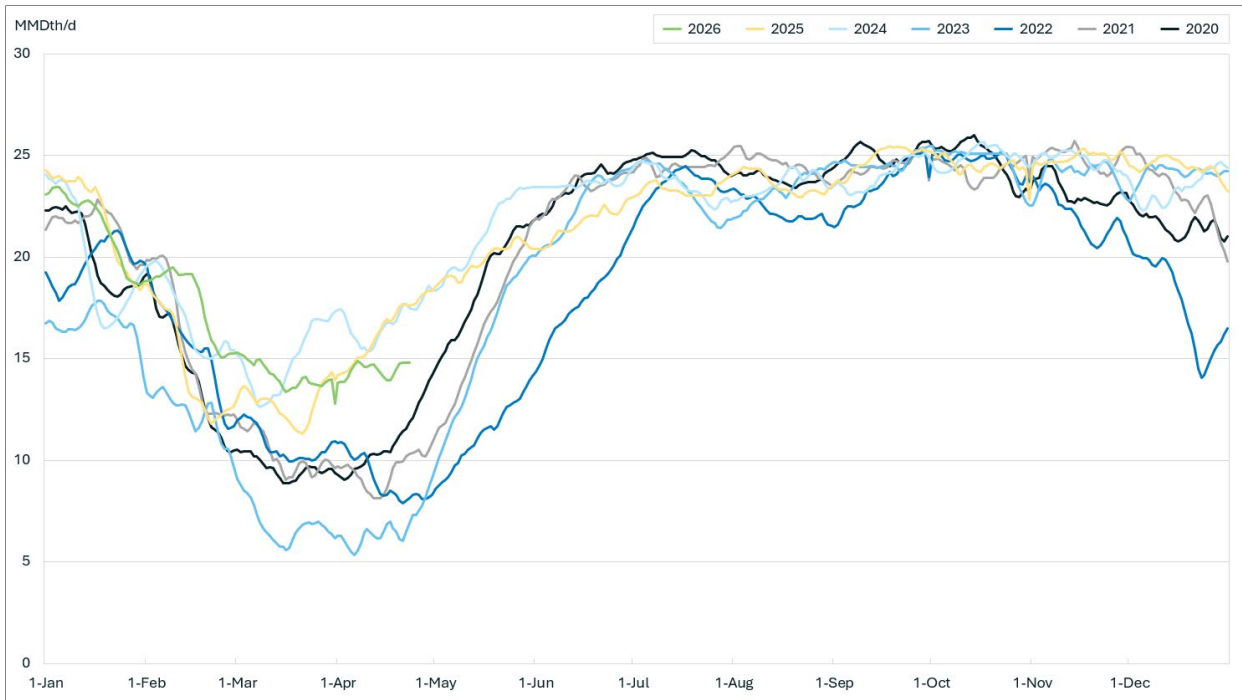

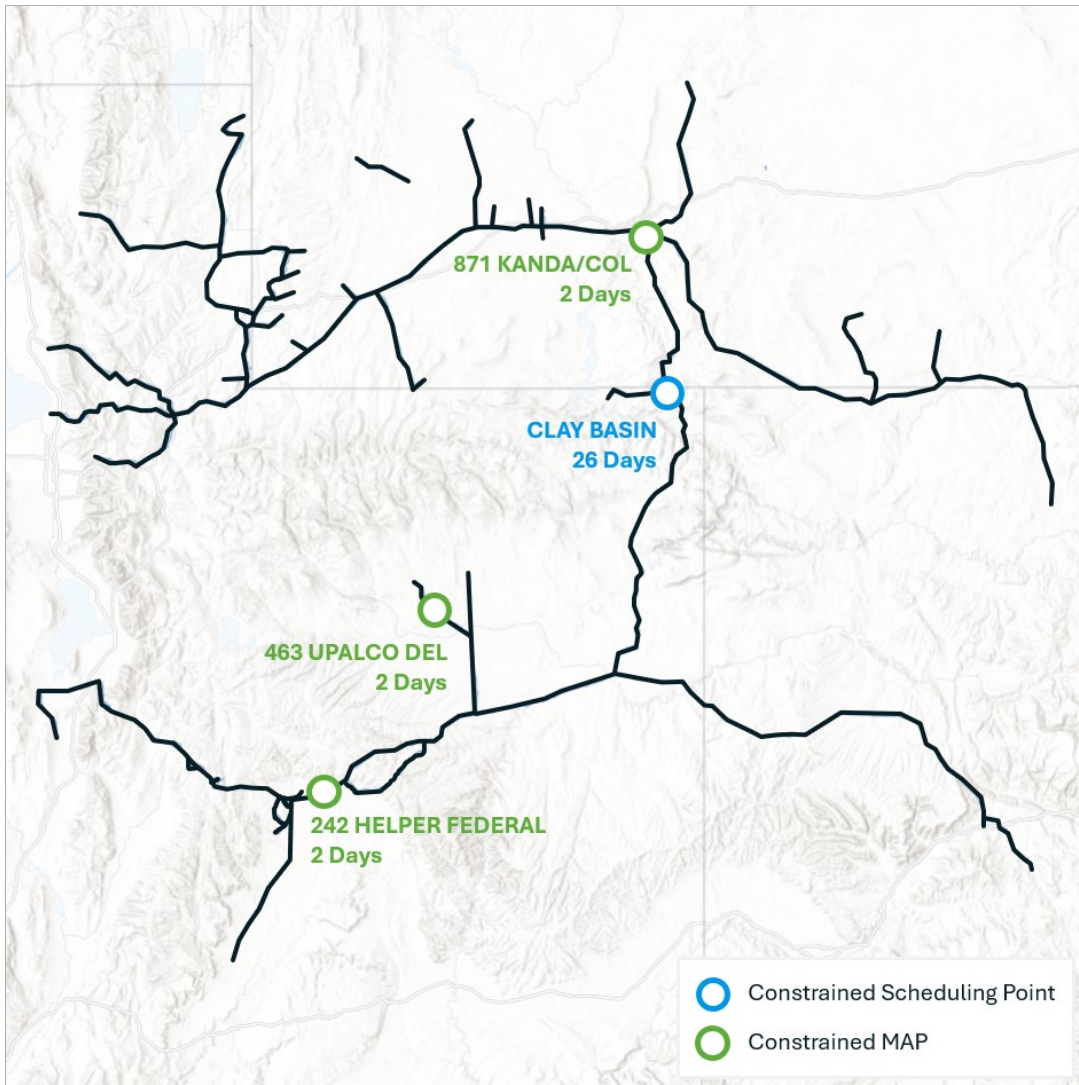
MOUNTAINWEST APRIL 2026 FUEL GAS REIMBURSEMENT PERCENTAGE
