2024 Line 1400 & 1401 Intermountain Pipe Replacement Project (CP24-87-000)

On May 17, 2024, the FERC issued the Environmental Assessment Report for Northwest's 2024 Line 1400 & 1401 Intermountain Pipe Replacement Project to remove and replace approximately 3.52 miles of existing Line 1400 pipeline, 2.02 miles of the existing Line 1401 pipeline, and associated facilities near Boise, Idaho. The purpose of the Project is to bring these sections of natural gas pipeline into compliance with the U.S. Department of Transportation and Pipeline Hazardous Materials Safety Administration high consequence area classification changed in the identified locations. Northwest began construction on May 30, 2024, and expects to place the Project facilities into service by November 3, 2024.

Soda Springs Compressor Replacements (CP24-471-000)

On May 29, 2024, Northwest filed a 30-day 2.55(b) Advance Notification of the replacement of compression facilities at its Soda Springs Compressor Station. On June 6, 2024, the FERC issued the related Environmental Assessment Report. Construction activities are anticipated to commence in July 2024 with a target in-service date of October 31, 2025.
